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North Carolina Statewide Telepsychiatry Program (NC-STeP)



NC-STeP Quality Management and Outcomes Monitoring Processes: April – June 2019

- The Median Length of Stay was 25.5 hours
- The Average Length of Stay was 46.8 hours
 - 45.9 hours for those discharged to home
 - 63.7 hours for those transferred to another facility
- Average Consult Elapsed Time (in Queue to Exam Complete) for Model 1 hospitals was 3 hours and 13 minutes.





NC-STeP Quality Management and Outcomes Monitoring Processes: April – June 2019

- 661 ED patients who received telepsychiatry services had an IVC in place during their ED stay.
 - 236 (35.7%) of those patients did not have an IVC in place when discharged.
- Of the ED patients who received telepsychiatry services,
 41.4% were discharged to home. 21.4% were discharged to another facility.





NC-STeP Quality Management and Outcomes Monitoring Processes: April – June 2019

Notes:

- Data for Novant hospitals was not included in this report, pending receipt of corrected data for Novant.
- Percent of patients discharged to another facility ("transfer") is lower than normal due to a high number of patients coded as "other."
- Data for Cone hospitals did not include a discharge disposition, so it was coded as "other".
- Data for Mission hospitals contained ambiguous disposition codes, which were coded as "other".
- Bladen hospital did not submit data for May or June.



April - June 2019








Percent of use by Hospital Apr-Jun 2019

(based on number of patient encounters)








Number of Patients by Provider (Model 1)










Number of Patients by Model (Full Fiscal Year 2018-19)



















Median Length of Stay for Apr-Jun 2019 = 25.4 Hours





















Median Length of Stay by Quarter

Average Length of Stay by Quarter for Hospitals Participating in NC-STeP (in hours)





Average Length of Stay by Year (in hours)





Average Length of Stay by Quarter for Patients Discharged to Home or Transfer (in hours)








Average Length of Stay by Provider

Apr-Jun 2019 (in hours)









Average Length of Stay for NC-STeP Patients by Hospital


April - June 2019 (in hours)






Consult Elapsed Time: April – June 2019











Key Processes and Elapsed Times Averages April - June 2019







Percent of Patients by Discharge Disposition






IVCs - By Release Status






Number of IVCs and IVCs Turned Over by Year


Number of IVCs and IVCs Turned Over by Quarter








Number of IVCs and IVC Turnovers by Model Apr-Jun 2019








NC-STeP Charge Mix – Project to Date

























NC-STeP Status as of June 30, 2019

- 57 hospitals in the network. 53 live.
- 38,383 total psychiatry assessments since program inception
- 5,195 IVCs overturned
 - Cumulative return on investment = \$28,053,000
 (savings from preventing unnecessary hospitalizations)
- Eight Clinical Provider Hubs with 54 consultant providers
- Administrative costs below industry standard
- Over 30% of the patients served had no insurance coverage
